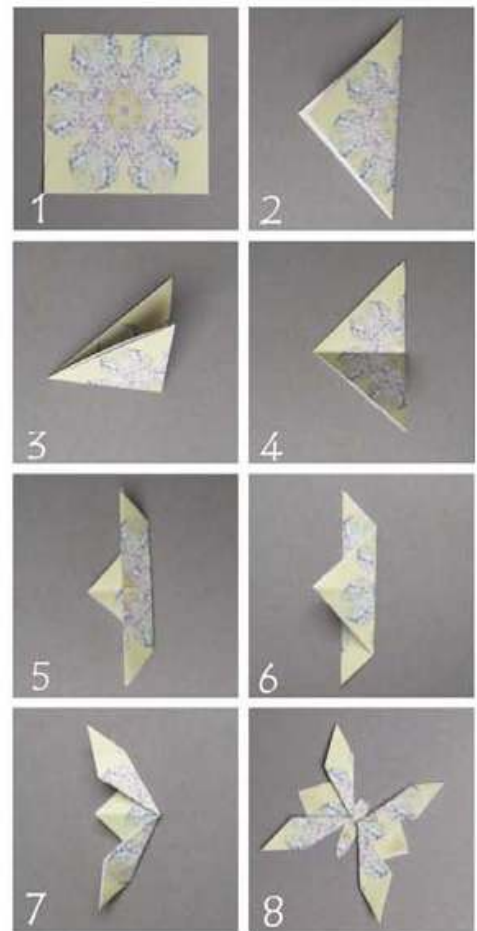


BUTTERFLIES

1. Cut out the square carefully leaving no border around it.
2. Fold corner to corner with the image on the outside creating a triangle shape.
3. Fold the triangle shape in half creating a smaller triangle. This last fold will create for you a central line when you open it.
4. Open the last triangle.
5. With the triangle that is left, fold over the long side so it covers around two thirds of the triangle shape.
6. Turn this over.
7. Taking the ends (top and bottom) fold them part way towards the central fold line creating 2 wings for your butterfly. (You can vary the size of these folds as there are many different sizes of butterflies, and the top and bottom wings can also be different sizes)
8. Cut out from the centre of another square a small rounded rectangle to make up the body of your butterfly and glue wing next to it and overlapping. Cut out another square and fold to make the second wing and glue in place to have your butterfly. Later you can draw on antennae with a felt pen or crayon.



FANS

1. Cut out the square carefully leaving no border around it.
2. Fold it corner to opposite corner with image on the outside to create a central fold line inside and then open back into a square with blank side uppermost.
3. Fold two opposite corners in towards the central fold line creating a kite shape.
4. Turn this kite shape over.
5. Trim along the edge of it following the white lines in the design to create a kite with a more decorative edge.
6. Repeat this for a second square and glue this second one in a way that overlaps the first in a fan shape.
7. Cut out 5 or 6 further squares and repeat your folding and cutting, to create the segments of the fan, gluing each one in turn to the one underneath it.
8. Finally cut out one last square, and repeating the process create a fan holder.
